

LEAGUE RULES

Due to scheduling difficulties, Team Madness has recently changed its format to more tournament-style racing instead of season-long points accumulating racing as we have done for over 11 mini-seasons. We did, however, keep our "SPEC 19T" rules for the stadium trucks. Below are the rules for the 2007 season which, as always, are subject to change.

SPEC 19T 2WD ELECTRIC STADIUM TRUCK TOURNAMENTS

Motors: Any 19T Motor (fixed or adjustable timing allowed, any brush or magnets allowed)

Batteries: Limited to 6 cells only. Unlimited capacity (Ni-cd, Ni-mh).

ESCs: Unlimited (with and without reverse)

Race Length: Varies on race

Pit Stops: Varies on race

Protests: Any driver wishing to protest must do so within 24 hours of event. Any ruling or judgments must be made by majority vote of all members of the league, excluding involved parties.

APRIL FOOL'S FEST TOURNAMENT (April 2, 2007)

First two races are optional warm-up races. Tournament champion is the winner of the IRONMAN 1000
10 minute race.

APRIL DRIVE FOR 5 TOURNAMENT (April 23, 2007)

Drivers earn points based on finish in each of 5 races. Driver with most points is the tournament champion. In the event of a tie, the driver with the most wins will be declared the champion. If necessary, the final tiebreaker will be a race-off between tied drivers.

1st - 10 points

2nd - 8 points

3rd - 7 points

4th - 6 points
5th - 5 points
6th - 4 points
7th - 3 points

MAY TOURNAMENT (May 14, 2007)

Drivers earn points based on finish in each of 4 races. Driver with most points is the tournament champion. In the event of a tie, the driver with the most wins will be declared the champion. If necessary, the final tiebreaker will be a race-off between tied drivers.

1st - 10 points
2nd - 8 points
3rd - 7 points
4th - 6 points
5th - 5 points
6th - 4 points
7th - 3 points
